Waterproof and comfortably cushioned, with great traction. 3 **Leica Pinmaster II** £495 (020 7629 1351, leica-storemayfair.co.uk). This new, waterproof laser rangefinder can measure the precise distance to a pin from up to 820 yards

Weighing less than 4lbs, this streamlined bag is surprisingly roomy – with seven pockets and an ergonomic shoulder strap to spread the load. 5 **TaylorMade R11 TP driver** £349 (as before); **Cleveland Ultralite Launcher XL 270 driver** £239 (clevelandgolf.com); **Titleist 910 D2 driver** £300 (01480 301114, titleist.co.uk). The new Cleveland driver is super-light but powerful; the other two allow you to adjust the club head to suit your swing. 6 **FootJoy Spidr2 glove** £12 (as before). Maintains grip in all weather; made from water-resistant leather and breathable mesh
